

Danceology Performing Arts Camp Policies & Procedures

1. Registration & Payment Policy

A 50% non-refundable deposit is required at the time of registration to secure your child's spot.

The remaining balance must be paid in full by May 23, 2026.

- Registration is first come, first served
- Spots are limited
- Registrations are not considered complete until payment is received

All payments are non-refundable after the final payment deadline.

2. Cancellation Policy

If a participant withdraws from the camp:

- The initial deposit is non-refundable
- No refunds will be issued after May 23, 2026

Danceology reserves the right to cancel or modify the camp if necessary. In such cases, families will be notified and appropriate accommodations will be made.

3. Drop-Off & Pick-Up Policy

Camp hours are 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

- Drop-off begins at 7:45 AM
- Pickup must occur no later than 5:30 PM

Campers will only be released to individuals listed on the authorized pickup list.

- Identification may be required at pickup
- Late pickups may result in additional fees

4. Attendance & Participation

Campers are expected to attend all scheduled days and participate in camp activities to the best of their ability.

Regular attendance is important for:

- Learning choreography
- Participating in rehearsals
- Preparing for the final performance

5. Health & Illness Policy

For the safety of all participants:

- Campers who are sick or showing symptoms of illness should remain at home
- Danceology reserves the right to send a camper home if they are unable to safely participate due to illness

Parents/guardians will be contacted if a child becomes ill during the day.

6. Medical & Emergency Policy

Parents/guardians must provide accurate medical information during registration.

In the event of an emergency:

- Danceology staff will make every effort to contact a parent/guardian
- If a parent/guardian cannot be reached, staff may seek appropriate medical care

Parents/guardians are responsible for any medical expenses incurred.

7. Medication Policy

Any medications must be disclosed during registration.

- Medication administration must be coordinated with staff
- Campers may only self-administer medication if indicated and approved by a parent/guardian

8. Behavior & Conduct Policy

To ensure a safe and positive environment, campers are expected to:

- Follow staff instructions
- Treat others with respect
- Participate appropriately in activities

Danceology reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose behavior is:

- Disruptive
- Unsafe
- Inappropriate

No refunds will be issued in the event of dismissal.

9. Safety & Supervision Policy

Campers will be supervised by Danceology staff at all times during camp activities.

- Campers must notify staff before leaving an activity area (including restroom use)
- Only one or two campers may be out of the room at a time

High school helpers assist staff but are not responsible for supervision or discipline decisions.

10. Bathroom Policy

Danceology Studios has two single-stall restrooms.

- Campers will use restrooms individually
- Campers must inform staff before leaving for the restroom
- Staff will monitor usage to ensure safety and accountability

11. Food & Nutrition Policy

Danceology will provide daily snacks and drinks.

Campers must bring a packed lunch Monday–Thursday.

Parents/guardians should:

- Clearly label all food items
- Notify staff of any allergies

Danceology is not responsible for food brought from home.

12. Clothing & Dress Code

Campers should wear comfortable, movement-friendly clothing each day.

- Dance shoes are not required
- Closed-toe tennis shoes are acceptable

For the final performance, campers must wear:

- Camp t-shirt (provided)
- Black shorts or legging-style pants
- Closed-toe tennis shoes

13. Photography & Media Policy

Danceology may photograph or record camp activities for promotional purposes.

Parents/guardians may opt in or out of media participation during registration.

14. Liability Waiver

Participation in camp activities involves inherent risks, including physical activity.

By enrolling, parents/guardians:

- Acknowledge and accept these risks
- Agree to release and hold harmless Danceology, its owners, instructors, staff, and affiliates from any claims or liability arising from participation

15. Additional Opportunities

Campers may have the opportunity to participate in a 4th of July performance.

- Participation is optional
